Insight

Lately, due to the mounting instances of pirate attacks on sea-crafts in various regions of the world, the International Maritime organization and many registration offices in various countries, particularly the USA are changing their attitude and are in a process of encouraging use of protection on board, lethal and NON lethal.

In light of the demand for protection solutions to the growing naval transportation, we at ISA-Israel decided to share with colleagues worldwide our know how and practical experience in struggling (with great successes) the Maritime piracy/terror since more than 60 years.

The Israeli pro active protection concepts, methods and tactics are adapted and used these days in order to overcome and mitigate the piracy attacks.

Pirate attacks on Israeli sea vessels have not succeeded to this day.

An international flotilla of ships from American, Russian, Indian, British, and French navies tries to provide some security to oil tankers and other commercial maritime traffic, particularly in front of the (very long) Somali coastline, but these forces are stretched in across vast areas, and even at the best of times can barely cover only oil choke points such as Bab-El-Mandeb, and the straits of Hormuz and Malacca.

So how do we mitigate against maritime piracy, and even worse so against maritime terrorism?

One of the proved solutions is to staff each seagoing merchant ship with an on-board armed Sea Marshals.

This measure, used routinely by the Israeli merchant fleet, is especially desirable for oil and LNG tankers - cargos that can best serve the purposes of terrorists. Such services, provided by multiple private security organizations, cost expensive a day. In view of the potential dangers and the high cost of ransoms, and the infinitely higher costs of a successful maritime-borne terror attack, this appears to be a reasonable cost,

- **Ship owners around the world are hiring private security firms to accompany their fleets around the Horn of Africa following the dramatic increase in piracy in the region.**

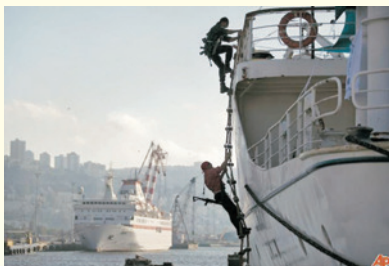
